



## ONTARIO CHAPTER BURSARY APPLICATION

The CMVA Ontario Chapter shall award three (3) \$1000 bursaries each year. The bursaries are intended to provide financial assistance to current Ontario Chapter members, or their spouses, or their children while they are attending Canadian colleges or universities full time; and to promote the study in mechanical vibration and related fields.

### ELIGIBILITY & RULES

1. A current CMVA Ontario Chapter member or his/her spouse or child may apply.
2. The applicant must be a Canadian or a permanent resident of Canada and attending a Canadian university, college or an equivalent institute full time (minimum 3 credited courses per semester).
3. Students in all programs and disciplines are encouraged to apply.
4. Under-graduate and graduate studies are eligible.
5. Previous successful and unsuccessful applicants may reapply. Maximum 2 bursaries (in separate years) per an individual.
6. Selections for the awards will be based on point scheme. The Chapter Executives will each determine points for every applicant. The three applicants with the most total points will be selected for the awards.
7. Any Chapter Executive who has applied themselves or has a spouse/child applying for the bursary will abstain from voting.
8. There are no appeals on bursary decisions.
9. The application must be received by the Chapter Technical Chair by September 30<sup>th</sup>.
10. A letter will be sent to each applicant indicating the outcome of their bursary application.
